ITINERARY

DAY 1: SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 21

DEPARTURE FROM US

Afternoon departure from the US on an overnight flight to Israel - The Holy Land.

DAY 2: SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 22

ARRIVAL

Welcome to Israel! Upon your arrival, you'll be met and assisted with your luggage by our tour representative, who'll escort you to our guide and driver. On our journey to Tiberias and our hotel, we'll stop at Caesarea. It was here that Paul was imprisoned and tried, and Cornelius was converted. In the evening, we'll enjoy a special welcome reception and dinner together.

DAY 3: MONDAY, NOVEMBER 23

GALILEE

Our first stop today will be the Mt. of Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Then on to the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter, built on the spot where the resurrected Jesus appeared to Peter and restored him after his three-fold denial. From here, we'll go to the upper Galilee and Caesarea Philippi where Jesus foretold His death. We'll lunch at a seaside restaurant on the same local fish that Peter, James and John caught, followed by a scenic boat ride across the Sea of Galilee. We'll dock near Capernaum, the home of the three fishermen and hub of Jesus' ministry. At the end of day, it's back to the hotel where we'll dine together.

MT. PRECIPICE



DAY 4: TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 24

The day will start with a drive to Mt. Carmel, where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Next it's the Jezreel Valley and a visit to Tel Megiddo with its majestic view overlooking the valley where the battle of Armageddon is to take place. From there, we'll visit the village of Nazareth, and the end of our tour day at Mt. Precipice, where the angry mob attempted to throw Jesus off the cliff because they did not like what he had preached at the temple. Then it's back to the hotel to enjoy dinner.

DAY 5: WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 25


GILGAL - DEAD SEA - MASADA

We'll have an early departure from Galilee to Gilgal where John the Baptist baptized Jesus. We'll continue south to Masada, the final stronghold of the Jews against the Romans, where we'll ascend by cable car and tour the famed site. From there, we'll descend to the Dead Sea and a buoyant, unsinkable swim. Afterward, we'll head to Jerusalem and the Mt. Zion Hotel, our home for the next four days, and dinner.

DAY 6: THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 26

JERUSALEM

We'll begin our day with a tour at the Mt. of Olives and its view of the Golden Gate through which Jesus will enter Jerusalem. We'll walk the traditional Palm Sunday route to the Churches of Dominus Flevit and All Nations at the Garden of Gethsemane, and proceed to the Christian Quarter and the Pool of Bethesda and Church of St. Anna. We'll follow the steps of the Via Dolorosa and visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. After lunch on our own, we'll continue to the Jewish Quarter and the Western Wall. The day ends with a visit to the Garden Tomb and a special, private Thanksgiving feast at our hotel.



DAY 7: FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 27

JERUSALEM

Today we'll start with a drive by the Knesset (Israel's parliament) on our way to the Israel Museum. From there we'll proceed to Mt. Zion and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. We'll walk the very steps that Jesus walked when He was taken from the high priest's house for his midnight trial. We'll descend into the pit (now a chapel) where He was imprisoned as His fate was decided by the Sanhedrin. The remainder of the day and dinner on your own.

DAY 8: SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 28

VALLEY OF ELAH

We'll begin the day at the Valley of Elah, site of the famous battle between David and Goliath. The afternoon is yours to take an optional tour such as Hezekiah's Tunnel and the Pool of Siloam and/or walk the walls of the Old City. In the evening, we'll have our farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 9: SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 29
