## DAY 1: MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

### DEPART USA

Depart the US for an overnight flight to Prague.

## DAY 2: TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 15

### PRAGUE

Arrive in Prague - Our tour escort will meet all those who arrive on flights before 11:00 AM. Transfer to hotel where you will be greeted by Dr. Petterson who will take those who are interested on a one to two hour walking tour of the area surrounding our hotel. This evening we will meet together for our welcome wine and appetizer reception. Overnight in Prague.

## DAY 3: WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16

### PRAGUE

This morning we will depart on a full day tour of Prague taking in such historic sites as Old Town Square, Old Town Hall, the Church of St. Michael, St. Charles University and more. Dinner on own - Overnight Prague

## DAY 4: THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 17

### PRAGUE TO WITTENBERG

An early departure from Prague via motor coach for Wittenberg. Once in Wittenberg we will see the main sites connected to Martin Luther including the Schlosskirche (Castle Church) where he nailed his famous 95 Theses to the door in 1517. We will also visit St. Mary's Church and tour the Lutherhaile (Luther House) Museum where Luther lived for 35 years. Continue to our hotel in Wittenberg. Overnight - Dinner at hotel



## DAY 5: FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 18

### WITTENBERG TO ERFURT, EISENACH AND FRANKFURT

After breakfast we will take the train to Erfurt where Luther spent time as a monk. Upon arrival we will be taken on a walking tour including St. Mary's Cathedral where Luther was ordained. Our next stop will be a tour of The Augustinian Monastery and it's Luther exhibition. After a lunch break we will board our motor coach continue to Eisenach to visit the Wartburg Castle where Luther stayed and translated the New Testament of the Bible into German. Continue to Frankfurt for an overnight. Dinner at hotel

## DAY 6: SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 19

### FRANKFURT TO WORMS AND STRASBOURG

This morning we will board our motor coach for a short drive to Worms for a walking tour to see the Reformation Monument. It was here, during the Imperial Diet in 1521 that Luther challenged the entire Catholic establishment by his refusal to recant the great doctrines of Protestantism. After a lunch break we will continue to the wonderful city of Strasbourg. After checking into our hotel there will be free to either choose to relax at the hotel, explore the immediate area or join Dr. Petterson on a short walking tour of the area. Overnight. Dinner on own.

## DAY 7: SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 20

### STRASBOURG

Today our tour will follow the steps of Jean Calvin. We start with the Strasbourg Cathedral where the Reformation began, see the Palais University and the St. Madeleine Church and St. Nicholas Church where Calvin preached and the house where he first lived. Overnight Strasbourg. Dinner on own



## DAY 8: MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 21

### GENEVA VIA EGUISHEIM AND GRUYERES

This morning we depart Strasbourg for Geneva with our first stop in the picturesque village of Eguisheim as we travel south on the Wine Trail and onto Gruyeres, famous for its cheese. We will enjoy lunch here and have time to wander the streets of this delightful town. We continue to Geneva where we will overnight. Dinner on own

## DAY 9: TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 22

### GENEVA

Today we will tour Geneva where Calvin, Knox, Farel and others brought Christ's teaching to eager listeners. Our tour will include a stop at the impressive Reformation Monument, Calvin's Church, The Reformation museum, the ruins of a Roman sanctuary and other sites. Overnight Geneva - dinner on own

## DAY 10: WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 23

### GENEVA

Today we will have a late departure to visit The Auditor de Calvin where Dr. Petterson will give a talk on Calvin and a summation of our trip. Balance of the day free to explore and shop! This evening we will all meet for our farewell dinner. Overnight Geneva

## DAY 11: THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24

### GENEVA

After breakfast at the hotel there will be one transfer to the airport at a time to be announced to coincide with the majority of departures. Return to the US.
